The Parkland College Board of Trustees Scholarship is a two-year scholarship awarded to the **top 10 percent** of District 505 high school graduates who attend Parkland full time immediately after high school.

THIS AWARD:

- covers **100%** of percent of tuition and fees\*  
(pending Board of Trustee approval in December 2023)
- is renewable for Year Two based on first-year GPA (3.0) and completing 24 credit hours

\*does not include Aviation flight fees
